

RULES FOR USE OF THE HOUSE CHAMBERS

Please observe the following rules to help us maintain the atmosphere of respect and decorum that has long been a tradition within these walls.

Please remember, these desks are the Representatives' "offices" throughout the year and the only places they have to work and leave their belongings when they are here; please do not disturb anything you may find in and around the desks.

Use of Chamber may not be scheduled without written permission of the Speaker.

- Absolutely no food or drink is allowed in the House Chamber or Gallery.
- Please do not use a Representative's phone.
- The front Chamber doors are to remain closed at all times. You may enter and exit the chambers from the doors on either side.
- The microphone at the Speaker's desk and the microphone at the clerk's desk may be activated.
- The electronic voting system and the microphones at the individual desks are not available.
- The microphones are very fragile and should not be handled.
- The Chamber should be left in the same condition in which you found it. In other words, please make sure all materials are either taken with you or discarded.
- No loud or disorderly conduct or demonstrations of any kind are allowed.
- Use of the House Chamber is available during regular business hours: 9:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday.
- You will be liable for any damages incurred during your use of the Chamber.
