



Utah State 4-H Scholarship Descriptions

Amy Kearsley Merit Scholarship

Scholarship for tuition, student fees, etc. for 1 year (2 semesters) at Utah State University in Logan.

Donor: The Amy Kearsley Scholarship Endowment and the Utah 4-H Foundation

Qualifications:

- Be a high school student planning to attend Utah State University for the upcoming Fall semester. (This does not include those enrolling in the Weber College of Nursing Program at USU.)
- Have and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Have been a resident of Utah and member of Utah 4-H for a minimum of 2 years and have outstanding 4-H achievements in Leadership, Citizenship, Agriculture and/or Family Life.
- Have not received a President's Leadership Council or other full tuition waiver.
- Submit the required application and materials before the due date.
- Become an active member of the Collegiate 4-H student organization.
- Be majoring in the College of Agriculture or Family, Consumer, and Human Development.

Daniels Fund Scholarship

The Daniels Fund Scholarship was created by Bill Daniels who believed in the value of a college education. This scholarship seeks students who are described by Bill Daniels as "diamonds in the rough". Mr. Daniels wanted to seek out student with a clear financial need, but who may not necessarily be at the top of their class. This Scholarship is for students who may not have been sought out by other scholarship programs, but who show potential to be successful in college, to become leaders, and to impact their community.

To be eligible to apply for the Daniels Scholarship, students must:

- Contact the County 4-H Agent or staff to express interest in the Daniels Scholarship. The County Agent will make nominations to the State 4-H Office.
- Be on track to graduate from high school in 2016.
- Be eligible to receive federal financial aid (a US citizen or a qualified non-citizen as defined and permitted under federal law).
- Be "college-ready".
 - Take the ACT or SAT and achieve an exam composite of 17 or higher (ACT) or 810 or higher, combined math and verbal (SAT).
 - Apply to at least three colleges, with at least two being in-state.
- Demonstrate "Daniels Scholar" characteristics.
 - Academic performance or promise.
 - Strength of character.
 - Leadership potential, emotional maturity, and stability.
 - Well-rounded personality, abilities, and broad interests
 - The potential to contribute to one's community later in life

Gardner-Ellis Scholarship

Scholarship is to be used toward the cost of tuition at Utah State University in Logan.

Donor: The Gardner-Ellis Scholarship Endowment

This scholarship is designed to be a "helping hand" to outstanding 4-H members who need a little help toward the cost of education. It could also be presented to a 4-H leader returning to school who has given to others and now could use a little help in return.

Qualifications:

- Be graduating from high school or a college undergraduate currently enrolled, or planning to enroll, at Utah State University for the upcoming Fall semester. (This does not include those enrolling in the Weber College of Nursing Program at USU.)
- Have and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Have been a resident of Utah and member of Utah 4-H for a minimum of 2 years and have outstanding 4-H achievements.
- Have not received a President's Leadership Council or other full tuition waiver.
- Submit the required application and materials before the due date.
- Become an active member of the Collegiate 4-H student organization.
- Have a good academic record showing potential.

Fern Kelley Scholarship

Scholarship is to be used toward the cost of tuition at Utah State University in Logan.

Donor: The Fern Shipley Kelley Scholarship Endowment

Qualifications:

- Be a high school student planning to attend Utah State University for the upcoming Fall semester. (This does not include those enrolling in the Weber College of Nursing Program at USU.)
- Have and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Have been a resident of Utah and member of Utah 4-H for a minimum of 2 years and have outstanding 4-H achievements in Leadership, Citizenship, Agriculture and/or Family Life.
- Have not received a President's Leadership Council or other full tuition waiver.
- Submit the required application and materials before the due date.
- Become an active member of the Collegiate 4-H student organization.
- Be majoring in the College of Family, Consumer, and Human Development.

Utah State 4-H Horse Council Scholarship

Scholarship for tuition, student fees, etc. at any accredited school.

Donor: Utah State 4-H Horse Council Scholarship

Qualifications:

- Participated as an active member of the Utah State 4-H Horse Program for at least the last three years of 4-H eligibility and have outstanding 4-H achievements in Leadership and Citizenship.
- Be graduating from high school or a college undergraduate currently enrolled, or planning to enroll in continuing education.
- Have and maintained a minimum 3.0 GPA or equivalent.
- Have not received a full tuition waiver.
- Submit the required application and materials before the due date.
- Submission Information

Portfolios and applications must be mailed to the Utah State 4-H Horse Council President by March 1st. Any late entries will not be considered for the scholarship. Please submit information to: Chris Hansen PO Box 521 Oakley, UT 84055.

*To apply for both a Utah State 4-H Scholarship and a Utah State 4-H Horse Council Scholarship you must submit two separate applications. Your portfolio and applications must be delivered to the State 4-H Office no later than 5:00 PM on February 15th. After your portfolio and application have been judged for the Utah State 4-H Scholarships, your portfolio and Utah 4-H Horse Council Application will be delivered to the Utah State 4-H Horse Council President by a member of the State 4-H Office.

Scholarship Awards: Scholarship awards will be limited to the following criteria:

- The maximum scholarship awarded to any participant will be limited to \$5,000 unless otherwise specified by a sponsor.
- The scholarship will be applied toward the cost of books and tuition only.
- The scholarship proceeds will be made payable to the school/institution not the applicant.
- Scholarship funds will be paid out to the school/institution as needed or requested. Any unused balance will be returned into the scholarship fund for future use.
- Scholarship awards will be announced in March giving the applicant ample time to pay for tuition and books.
- Candidates who have been selected to receive the current year's scholarship will be notified privately during the month of March prior to the formal announcement.
- Scholarship funds are to be used within an 18 month period form the award date. Any unused balance will be returned to the Utah State 4-H Horse Council Scholarship Fund.

Von H. and Elaine Y. Jarret Scholarship

Scholarship is to be used toward the cost of tuition at Utah State University in Logan.

Donor: The Von H. and Elaine Y. Jarrett Scholarship Endowment

Qualifications:

- Be graduating from high school or a college undergraduate currently enrolled, or planning to enroll, at Utah State University for the upcoming Fall semester. (This does not include those enrolling in the Weber College of Nursing Program at USU.)
- Have and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Have been a resident of Utah and member of Utah 4-H for a minimum of 2 years and have outstanding 4-H achievements in Leadership, Citizenship, Agriculture and/or Family Life.
- Have not received a President's Leadership Council or other full tuition waiver.
- Submit the required application and materials before the due date.
- Become an active member of the Collegiate 4-H student organization.
- Have a good academic record showing potential and demonstrate financial need.

Western AgCredit Scholarship

Scholarship is to be used toward the cost of tuition at Utah State University in Logan.

Donor: Western AgCredit

Qualifications:

- Be graduating from high school or a college undergraduate currently enrolled, or planning to enroll, at Utah State University for the upcoming Fall semester. (This does not include those enrolling in the Weber College of Nursing Program at USU.)
- Have and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- Have been a resident of Utah and member of Utah 4-H for a minimum of 2 years and have outstanding 4-H achievements in Leadership, Citizenship, Agriculture and/or Family Life.
- Have not received a President's Leadership Council or other full tuition waiver.
- Submit the required application and materials before the due date.
- Become an active member of the Collegiate 4-H student organization.
- Be majoring in the College of Agriculture.
